

Christian Blueprint


DEFINED

Who Needs this?




This is for the new Christian, who is just starting out in their walk with Christ.

#3


Set a schedule where you meet with God **daily** for prayer, guidance, reading the Bible, and to hear His voice.


THE BLUEPRINT
