Step 1: Take three consecutive days to sit quietly before the Lord without interruptions.

Step 2: Share your concerns and then listen for 15 minutes.

Step 3: After 15 minutes, record your experience.

Step 4: Repeat the above steps until you feel at peace about making changes, God's given you your first step, or you have decided what day you will begin.
